#### **1 ORGANISING AUTHORITY**

The 2020 F18 Catamaran West Australian State Championship will be organized by the Australian Formula 18 Catamaran Association with The Cruising Yacht Club (TCYC) the conducting authority, under the authority of Sailing Australia and World Sailing.

#### 2 RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 2.2 The prescriptions and special regulations of Australian Sailing
- 2.3 The rules as defined in the Equipment rules of Sailing.
- 2.4 The rules of the IF18C Association.
- 2.5 The 2020 F18 State Championships Sailing Instructions.
- 2.6 Rule 44.1 is changed so that a 2 turns penalty is replaced with a 1 turn penalty.
- 2.7 Appendix T Arbitration shall apply.

#### **3** ADVERTISING

3.1 Boats may be required to display event sponsor's logo. If required will be supplied by the organising authority.

#### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 Entry is open to all State Members of the Australian F18 Association.
- 4.2 All competitors shall be a financial member of a club affiliated to Australian Sailing through their relevant MYA.
- 4.3 Eligible boats may enter through the attached form and emailing to glenn@bulletproofcivil.com.au
- 4.4 Entries will be accepted up to the 10am on the 29th February 2020.

#### 5 FEES

5.1 Entry fee is \$75 payable direct to the organising committee.

#### 6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 There will be up to 8 races over 2 days
- 6.2 Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> February 10-11am Registration
- 6.3 Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> February 11:30am Briefing
- 6.4 Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> February Racing Session 1, warning not before 1pm
- 6.5 Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> February After Sailing Drinks at TCYC
- 6.6 Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> March Racing Session 2, warning not before 10am
- 6.7 Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> March Racing Session 3, warning not before 1pm
- 6.8 Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> March Presentation and BBQ

#### 7 MEASUREMENT

7.1 Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate.

#### 8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available from the TCYC website, or at registration.

#### 9 VENUE

- 9.1 The venue is The Cruising Yacht Club of WA, 2 Val St Rockingham.
- 9.2 The racing area will be on Mangles Bay.

#### 10 COURSE

10.1 The course will be windward/leeward type courses of 2 to 3 laps.

#### 11 SCORING

- 11.1 The scoring system will be the low point scoring system.
- 11.2 4 races will constitute a series.
- 11.3 When less than 5 races are completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.4 When 5-8 races are completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores minus her worst score.

#### 12 PRIZES

- 12.1 The F18 Western Australian State Championship Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the boat in 1<sup>st</sup> Place.
- 12.2 Trophies will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> place overall.
- 12.3 Other prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organising committee.

#### **13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to race. The organising authority and host club will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
