An Auditor (Inspector) cannot limit or reduce the complete and unlimited responsibility of the Owner or the person in charge as defined in the Fundamental Regulations. I have read and understand the Yachting Australia Special Regulations and Recommendations on pages 305-312 of the RRS ("Blue Book").

I undertake to maintain the boat and all its equipment in good order and condition as specified in these Regulations.

Where the Owner is not the Skipper (person in charge) I understand that the Skipper is the Owner's Representative for the time that they are in charge of the boat and that I will familiarise them with their responsibilities as stated in RRS 1 and 4 and these Special Regulations.

**DoT Exemption:** To avail yourself of the DoT equipment exemption for dinghies sailing from coastal yacht clubs you must be accompanied by a safety boat otherwise you must carry the same equipment as any other boat. The equipment required under the Navigable Waters Regulations includes: flares, PFD1, anchor and bilge pump or bucket and in some areas radio and EPIRB.
